

Occupational Health and Safety Policy

Connect NDT Ltd. is fully committed to achieving the highest levels of occupational health and safety. The method for achieving this is detailed in the documented OH&S Management System which is based on BS OHSAS 18001:2007 requirements.

The Company shall ensure that OH&S risks appropriate to the nature and scale of the organisation are fully detailed in risk assessments describing hazards, risks, controls and further actions required to mitigate or remove any potential for injury. Assessments are periodically reviewed to ensure that they remain valid within the defined scope of the OH&S management system and are appropriate to the nature and scale of operational activities whilst taking account of client and associated contractor needs.

Connect NDT is fully committed to the prevention of injury and ill health by continual improvement of the OH&S Management System. This will be achieved by communicating regularly with employees to highlight the potential for injury and ill health to ensure a full understanding of hazards and the associated risks.

The Company shall ensure that appropriate OH&S Legislation is monitored and reviewed periodically, using external agencies where necessary. The purpose of the review will be to ensure that the company meets or exceeds legislative compliance at all times. Consideration will also be given to compliance with other requirements that relate to its OH&S hazards.

The Company shall consider the impact of risks when setting and reviewing OH&S Objectives. Objectives shall be established annually and monitored and reviewed as necessary to ensure they remain appropriate to the organisation with the objective of the improvement of OH&S performance.

The Managing Director shall ensure that this OH&S policy is fully documented, implemented, maintained and periodically reviewed to ensure it remains current. It will be communicated to all persons working under the control of the organisation and stakeholders by use of the company noticeboards, website and through employee training to ensure that staff are made aware of their individual OH&S responsibilities and obligations.
