



Health, Safety & Environmental Policy Statement

Connect NDT is committed to the health and safety of people, the protection of assets and to improving its use of natural resources and preventing pollution.

The Company's procedures and method statements describe the requirements for the safe function of our operations and ensure that work is conducted in an environmentally friendly manner, both on our own premises and on our customers' premises. It shall be ensured that Connect NDT complies with relevant national and international regulations and the relevant standards and guidelines.

The framework documents on which the Management System and its supporting documents are based upon, include the current issues of HS(G) 65, "Guidelines for Successful Health and Safety Management" and Health and Safety Legislation.

It is the Connect NDT policy that, so far as is reasonably practicable, the Company shall conduct all of its activities in such a way as to:

- Avoid harm to all personnel and assets that may be affected by its business
- Avoid harm to the environment where impacted by its business
- Seek progressive improvement of its health and safety performance
- Comply with all applicable legislative requirements and with all other requirements to which the organisation subscribes (which relates to environmental aspects).

Statement of objectives

- Achieve zero lost time accidents and incidents and environmental pollution events
- Minimise non-lost time accidents, incidents and hazardous occurrences, including environmental incidents
- Provide a healthy and safe place of work for all employees
- Minimise the environmental impact of activities by efficient use of resource and waste reduction.

Statement of implementation actions

To achieve these objectives, Connect NDT seeks to:

- Adopt safe and environmentally friendly working practices in its business
- Develop a high level of health, safety and environmental awareness and alertness amongst all employees
- Firmly establish health, safety and environmental issues as everyone's responsibility
- Provide competent personnel who are suitably qualified, trained and equipped
- Encourage the involvement and co-operation of all employees to fulfil their obligations under this policy to care for both their own safety and that of others
- Ensure that employees co-operate fully with safe systems of work in force at any worksite
- Conduct all work using controlled procedures and method statements, which will incorporate suitable and sufficient appropriate risk assessment of all tasks
- Investigate root causes of all accidents, incidents and hazardous occurrences and take suitable corrective and long-term preventative action
- Ensure that equipment provided by the Company or on its behalf, is fit for its intended purpose
- Take into account customer health, safety and environmental requirements and ensure our personnel and sub-contractors are able to meet those requirements.
